ACCUMULATION OF STEPPING STONES:

- ✓ To encourage positive behaviour, stepping stones will cancel stumbling blocks.
- ✓ Discipline files will be reviewed every Thursday.
- ✓ Parents will be notified of rewards via the achievement card that is to be pasted in the learner's homework book. Kindly amend your signature as proof of acknowledgement.
- ✓ 25 merits will allow for the learner to wear CIVVIES on the 1st Tuesday of that week.
- √ 50 merits will result in the learner receiving a MERITUM CERTIFICATE at assembly level.
- ✓ 100 merits will allow the student to secure an AMBASSADOR SASH. The Ambassador Sash is to be handed out at assembly level and kept for a term. The school reserves the right to charge a fee for Loss/ Damage to the sash. Any accumulated merits will be carried over into the new term. They are valid for the year.

REMEDY PROGRAM

Foreword:

We at SBSM are of the firm belief that discipline should be done **"FOR the student and not TO the student."**

Students who consistently demonstrate negative behaviours will attain **STUMBLING BLOCKS**.

Before receiving a stumbling block, the learner will be given **3 verbal warnings**. This will allow for remediation and corrective discipline to occur. Thereafter, a stumbling block will be recorded on the learner's **achievement card** (This will be pasted in the student's homework book).

PLEASE NOTE:

Level 1 offences are regarded as **minor offences**. **Stepping stones cancel stumbling blocks.** Continuous transgressions will result in detention.

Level 2 offences are more serious transgressions. These demerits cannot be cancelled out with a merit. The parent will be contacted to discuss these offences.

ACCUMULATION OF STUMBLING BLOCKS:

- ✓ Only LEVEL 1 OFFENCES can CANCEL OUT WITH A STEPPING STONE.
- ✓ Discipline files will be reviewed every Thursday.
- ✓ 10 STUMBLING BLOCKS The learner will receive a detention slip a week in advance. The detention slip must be signed in order for the learner to sit for his/her detention. Detention will take place every Friday from 12.20 till 13.20 under teacher supervision.
- ✓ 20 STUMBLING BLOCKS The learner will receive his/her 2nd detention slip, warning letter will be issued. A parent-teacher meeting will be requested.
- √ 30 STUMBLING BLOCKS The learner will receive his/her 3r^d detention slip. A warning letter will be issued. A mandatory parent-teacher-HOD consultation will be called.

Depending on the nature of the offences, a disciplinary hearing with management may be requested.

STUMBLING BLOCKS EXPIRE at the end of each term and all learners will start afresh with the cycle at the onset of a new term. Thus giving them an opportunity to develop from previous transgressions.
